PROCEDURES & PENALTIES

- A. Two strokes** – Stroke Play
- B. Loss of Hole** – Match Play
- C. Play the ball as it lies** – No Penalty
- D. One Stroke:** Replay from where original ball was hit
- E. One Stroke:** Drop within 2 club lengths of where ball lies no nearer the hole
- F. One stroke:** Drop within 2 club lengths of where ball last crossed penalty area margin, no nearer hole or as far back on a line from the flag through where the ball last crossed the penalty area line. Measure from red line on ground or line between 2 red stakes.



G. One stroke: Drop as far back as desired on a line from flag through where ball lies

H. One stroke: Drop as far back as desired on a line through where the ball crossed the penalty area margin and the flag

I. Relief – No Penalty. Drop within one club length of nearest point of relief with longest club (not putter) no nearer hole.

J. Disqualification (Match and Stroke Play)

K. Two strokes: Drop outside the bunker back-on-the-line relief based on a line going back from hole through spot of original ball

L. One stroke: Drop inside the bunker back-on-the-line relief based on a line going back from hole through spot of original ball keeping the ball inside the bunker

M. Two Strokes: Drop a ball from a point in bounds near where the ball went out of bound and as far in bounds as within 2 club lengths into the fairway no closer to the hole

N. No Penalty

GENERAL GOLF ITEMS PERTINENT

- Search time for a ball is 3 minutes, any time longer is deemed as a lost ball
- Measuring a Drop (use longest club in bag except putter)
- Dropping Procedure – knee height
- Taking stance on wrong green is not permitted
- Touching Sand in bunker accidentally is permitted
- Loose Impediments can be removed anywhere including Bunkers and Penalty Areas
- Water Hazards are called penalty areas
- Casual water is referred to as abnormal course condition
- All damage to putting green can now be repaired
- Putting with the flagstick in is permitted
- Ball wedged against flagstick and side of hole is deemed as holed.
- All damage to putting green can be repaired
